Investigations and advice have been provided to quarriers, importers, merchants, roofers, slaters, designers, specifiers, architects and surveyors.

IBIS can provide assistance with the new British and European Standards for roofing slate, BS EN 12326, guiding you through the many tests and the problems that may arise with their interpretation. In particular there is the petrographic examination, where IBIS has considerable and possibly unrivalled experienced with carrying out the procedures and interpreting the findings.

The experience that IBIS has gained concerning UKAS governed slate testing allows us to offer an exclusive service whereby companies undertaking slate testing can be independently assessed. This is especially important for larger projects where testing regimes may become onerous if there are test failures that are not necessarily a fault of the slate or simply are not relevant for the site conditions.

Because IBIS can either organise testing or recommend who best can carry it out, the advice provided may be considered more objective than that which may be offered by those who undertake the testing themselves as part of their service.

The IBIS service is unique in that it specialises in natural roofing slate and combines geological skills with surveying practice. In addition to this combination of skills is the ability for the expert to get close to building problems by employing professional roped access when other methods may not be readily available (see our leaflet covering this subject).
